Scientific Program Committee Report

Theme: Trust & Care in Aviation Safety

The Scientific Program Committee will issue a first draft program which would be sent to the committee members. We are trying to create a program that will be of interest to a wide range of aerospace professionals, as well as other with an interest.

As we work together to defend the specialty for which we share a passion, and which will bring us together in Prague to help demonstrate the contribution we make to flight safety.

We are proposing to have sessions comprising invited speakers on specific topics, presentation of relevant abstracts, and panel discussions comprising invited speakers, abstract presenters and other experts.

The submission of abstracts will start earlier than presenters are accustomed to, likely to be later in 2017, and all topics will be welcomed but we would particularly welcome abstracts on the following:

- Preventive health.
- Psychosocial wellbeing.

- Psychological/Mental Health assessments.
- UAV operations, particularly health aspects for operators.
- Physiological/psychological aspects of space flight, including passenger travel
- The challenges of in-flight disorientation.
- The limitations of regulation in a rapidly changing health environment.
- Topic in military aviation including the differences between military and civilian operations.

“The Czech Republic is an important tourist destination. It offers visitors not only a multitude of historical landmarks but also diverse natural sites: mountains, ponds, caves and spas with mineral springs. The capital city of Prague is one of the most beautiful cities in the world, with unforgettable atmosphere of a metropolis whose history spans a millennium. Other regions of the country, not just the capital, also offer countless museums, galleries and landmarks.

The Czech Republic and its capital offer many protected cultural monuments, cities and villages.

Some basic information about Prague:

- Capital of the Czech Republic (EU member since 2004): 1,259.079 residents
- Currency: Czech koruna (CZK)
- Airport: Václav Havel Airport Prague, 30 minutes to downtown, www.prague.aero
- Distances: Berlin 350 km, Vienna 330 km, Budapest 530 km, Krakow 540 km

- Time: Central European Time (GMT+1); Central European Summer Time +1 (GMT+2)

- Climate: temperate, average annual temperature 9.0 °C; summer average 19.0 °C; winter average -0.9 °C

- Electrical voltage: 230 V

- National dialing code of the Czech Republic: +420

- The Vltava River flows through the city for 31 km; maximum width 330 m

- Historical centre: Castle District (Hradčany), Lesser Town (Malá Strana), Old Town (Staré Město), New Town (Nové Město) and Vyšehrad

The historical centre of Prague, which covers an area of 866 hectares, has been listed in the UNESCO World Cultural and Natural Heritage Register since 1992.”
