### 4. Advisory Board Committee Report:

a. Ries: The ESAM Scientific Advisory Board Committee (ABC), founded in 2007, provides independent scientific advice on aerospace medical issues. In 2023-2024, the ABC included members such as Ries Simons (Chair), with Marja Osinga and psychiatrist Diederik de Rooy joining the team. René Maire left, and Norbert Guettler replaced him, bringing cardiology expertise. ABC members were involved in ESAM Academy activities and the AsMA annual meeting, focusing on topics like mental health, reduced crew operations, and cardiology.

ABC's Circle of Experts addressed topics like ophthalmology, space medicine, and mental health. They worked on EU-funded projects (MESAFE for mental health and CaVD-PACE for cardiology). In 2024, the ABC will focus on promoting the Circle of



Experts, advancing mental health in aviation safety, and collaborating with key organizations like EASA, ICAO, and ASMA.
